




Symbolism

1. The juices of the grape are its life's produce: its life's blood.
2. Jesus referred to wine as His life's blood at the "Last Supper".
3. The "Wine Press" symbolizes the oppression that squeezes that life's blood from Mankind.
4. The resentment and anger that are brought on by oppression, ferment the anger that turns love into the hatred that sheds blood.
5. "Jacob's Well" was dug by Jacob, who then gathered witnesses and paid them to bear witness that he, Jacob, had dug the well that watered the flocks. Jacob, who was the first to be called "Israel", hence: the well of Israel. (Israel means "who prevails with God")
6. Jesus was the prophesied "Cornerstone" of the metaphorical "Temple" of God that He was sent to correctly possession on its foundation. He was the stone from which the waters of life, the Temple of God, flowed.
7. Jesus lamented to the Samaritan women at "Jacob's Well", that He "would" have given her the "Waters of Life".
8. Unfortunately, having come to offer the world "The Waters of Life", His first miracle was to turn the Jewish "Holy Water" into wine at His mother's request; and how the wedding party loved it: forsaking the "Holy Waters of Life" from Jesus, the well of Israel, for the blood and division of the oppression of the world.
9. The Hebrew Generation of "The Exodus" was barred from entering the "Promised Land" for their lack of faith concerning God's ability to "deliver" the waters (of life) from a "stone" in the desert: And so, the generation 40 years hence was "elected" by God to become the generation to enter The Promised Land.
10. Mohamed said that "The Torah", "The Psalms", and "The Gospel According to Christ", were three of four pillars. Suppose that, "The Torah", "The Prophets" and "The Gospel were instead, three of four corners in the metaphorical Temple.

11. The pyramid Δ was a symbol of oppression, like a winepress, over the Hebrews: just like the pyramid schemes of Wall Street, of Social Security, of "Seniority" and of Union and of Government, of Church Hierarchy and on and on and on; which press those who are not served by the pyramid, to serve the pyramid.
12. "Plumb bobs" come in many shapes. They are hung from strings over the pinpointed position of the "Cornerstone" to establish the location of the other corners using sighting devices. They are also hung to find "True Vertical" (true uprightness) when building the corners of a Temple, which are built first to establish the line of the wall.
13. Job 26:8 established that the rain clouds represent the "Waters Above".
14. Genesis 1:8, establishes that any earth which is not mire or swamp or quicksand or "Bottomless Pit", is "Heaven".
15. The heavenly "Garden of Eden" was the product, the produce, the fruit born of walking in God's Holy Ordinances: of following His Law. By acting as gods and making their own laws, Adam and Eve ate of the tree of knowledge that only God is wise enough to eat of and the fruit born of their action, the produce of their turning away, was their expulsion from that Heavenly place.
16. Solomon tells us (1st Kings, chapter 8:14-19), that God told his father David, not to build a Temple of stone: but to build a Temple in the heart. Yet following David's instructions, Solomon "Pressed" the Hebrews into "State" service to build the stone Temple in Jerusalem. The promise of continued oppression from Solomon's son and heir, ultimately caused the division of Israel. (Again, Israel means to "prevail with God").
17. Jesus said that "Heaven" was "at hand" and "is in the midst of you". Church steeples point up to the Heaven of the second resurrection in the "Afterlife". The traditional Mosques suggest a similar promise in their architecture. The Hebrews were torn between returning to the security of Egypt's pyramids and the promise of "The Promised Land", where the "Cornerstone" is properly placed upon its "foundation": established upon the Holy

foundation of “The Ten Commandments”” thus establishing the true location of all four corners, built “True Vertical” using the plumb bobs of Christianity  and The Gospel according to Christ; and Islam  and its insistence that Jesus was not God incarnate; and the Old Testament of Judaism  in its ancient struggle with its fear of leaving Egypt: A conflict between a Temple of stone that empowered the political pyramid of the State and the metaphorical Temple in the heart of Mankind built true to the plumb bob of God. A conflict described by David in the star that bears his name.

18. (1st Peter 2:5) “you yourselves, as living stones, are being built into a spiritual house for a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.”
19. The ascent begins with the building of the Temple in the heart. That Temple is built on the foundation, which is The Laws of God. The application of that Law promises free energy to Mankind in the fulfillment of the “Covenant of Salt” made with the Levitical priests: the keepers of the Law.
20. The “Black Community” has given the title of “The Moses Generation” to the generation of Blacks that stood up for their freedom in the ‘Civil Rights Movement’. But Moses was never a slave. To the contrary, he was born and raised to be King of Egypt. Metaphorically speaking, it was those young White Males in Levies who gave up their right to ascend through nepotism, who best represent Moses in these days: doing unto others what they would have done unto them; according to the Law. It was all those who were established through the nepotism of “Affirmative Action” who were not the “Black Males” it was designed to help, who represent those who did not keep the faith: Who did not trust in God’s deliverance, and who set us adrift these last forty years. Thankfully, now that you understand these things, you have become the “Generation Elect” to who it is promised to enter the “Promised Land”: Heaven on Earth. That is, of course, unless you would battle to serve the pyramid, in opposition to the building of the fourth corner and the walls of the Temple of God; and the casting of Satan into the bottomless pit for a thousand years. It is

not in the rituals of eating and singing and prostration, that God is glorified. Those are performed for the sake of public spectacle. It is in the observance of His Holy Ordinances that God's work is performed.

21. In the beginning there was a "Word" and the word was God. But Satan, that old deceiver, the serpent, put himself ahead of the "Word" and deceived Mankind into serving that perversion:

The battle for the hearts and minds of Mankind, the battle for evermore, the battle for Heaven over Hell, is waged with the Word of God; that issues from the mouth of His anointed, His elect; the "Body" of Christ rising from the Spiritual death lived and then abandoned by the "Prodigal Son": the first resurrection.
